PRESCHOOL

Preschool summer camps are for children who have turned 3 yrs old by 6/1/10 through rising Kindergarten students. All preschool camps are taught by Cliff Valley faculty. A 3-day camp is available for children who are 3 - 3 1/2 yrs old and a 5-day camp is available for children who are 3 1/2 - 5 yrs old.

We strive to maintain a student/teacher ratio of 6:1 in the 3-day camp and 9:1 in the 5-day camp, similar to our regular preschool program. Children bring their own lunch, including a beverage and a water bottle (please note: refrigeration will not be available). Snacks will be provided and are often prepared by the children. Please be aware that certain foods, such as nuts, may be banned from camp due to particular campers' allergies.

All preschool camps are 1 week in length from 9am-1pm each day.

ELEMENTARY

Elementary summer programs are for rising 1st-5th graders with the exception of Rock Band Camp, Jewelry Making, and Art of Games, which also accept rising 6th and 7th graders (specific age groups are listed in camp description). All elementary camps are taught by Cliff Valley faculty. Camps will meet from 9am-1pm, and students will need to bring a snack and lunch each day.

Extended care for elementary students:

- Before Care is available from 8-9am.
- Afternoon Explorations are available for campers from 1-5pm.

Applications must be received no later than, Friday, March 26.

Fill out the attached application and return it to Cliff Valley School with the appropriate fee. A confirmation email will be sent in April. You will then receive an email from your child's camp teachers with specific information and instructions before camps begin.

If enrollment is full when we receive your application, we will return your registration fee, and your name will be placed on the waiting list. If a space opens up, we will notify you and will expect payment within seven days of acceptance.

Afternoon Explorations is available for **elementary campers** from 1-5pm. Afternoon programs include a variety of fun activities, crafts, games and free play time both indoors and out.

Afternoon Explorations are \$125 per week.

Limited drop-in may be available for \$30/day.

All fees are due with each registration. Please make checks payable to Cliff Valley School.

If you need to cancel your registration, fees (excluding registration fees) are refundable until Friday, May 7. After that date all fees are non-refundable.

We will make every effort to notify one of the parents and/or call the child's physician, but we will be primarily concerned with the immediate care of the child. If necessary, the child will be taken to Egleston Hospital for any further treatment.
