Have some old favorite books taking up space on the book shelf? Here's an opportunity to trade in books you have already read for some different titles.

How it works

May 11 — May 20 Bring in your books to swap

Your books should be bundled with your permission slip and clearly labeled before you turn them in. Books may be dropped off in the library or in the Book Swap box in the lobby. Please label each book with your name. "Mystery" books will be treated as donations.

May 26 — May 28 Each class (K-5) will come to the library to choose books during their library time.

Choosing a Book to Drop off for the Swap

- Go through your room and find books that you no longer read and are willing to trade. No trading books that belong to your brother or sister, please!
- Books to swap must be in **good physical condition**. No loose pages or funny smells, please!
- Books to swap must be **actual bound books**. No pamphlets or kid's meal booklets, please!
- Books to swap must be close to **your own grade level**. We want elementary school level books to provide a good selection for all students at the swap.
- Don't choose a book that is really important to you — **all swaps are final**.

A Few More Book Swap Rules

- Hardcover books can be accepted but you might not find a hardcover to swap.
- Our space is limited so we can accept a maximum of 3 books per person for trading. You can pick one book at the swap for each one that you drop off ahead of time.
- Book swap will only take place during the regularly scheduled library times.
